Commuting to work

Length of commute



The average work day is nine hours long.



Current average commute is 35 minutes.



35.9% of respondents say their commute is "OK".

0-15 minutes is the "perfect" commute time.

Only 7%

of people used the words "cost effective" to describe their commute, so it seems that 93% of people don't perceive their commute as cost effective.

We asked respondents to tell us about their commute to the office, and what would improve it for them.

Mode of transport



57% of employees drive themselves to work.



23% of employees walk or cycle to work.

34% of people who currently drive to work would rather walk, but don't because work is too far from home.

How is your commute?

How do you think commuting will change in the future?

What do employers need to think about when making decisions about location?

We wanted to understand what employers and employees like and dislike about their office, and the impact their workspace has on their productivity and wellbeing. We explored what office workspaces would be like in the future - will they look and feel the same? We spoke to 409 people via online survey over a six week period in 2019. We're keen to keep talking.
