

REGULATION OF FIREARMS AND SHOTGUN SAFETY

I understand that holding a firearms licence is important for recreational gun owners, farmers, landowners and game keepers, and dealing with the application process in the right way, saves time and money.

The police have an important role to play in assessing the suitability of applicants for Firearms and Shotgun Certificates. A vetting process is undertaken to assess whether an applicant presents a risk to public safety. The police can remove licences for a number of reasons and if you consider their decision to be unreasonable, you have 21 days to appeal to the Crown Court from the refusal or notice of revocation.
