

### Receive £5,000 to kickstart your legal career

The Hewitson Grant offers £5,000 to help fund a legal qualification – whether that's a law degree or another route. It also includes work experience with us during your second or third year of study.

Getting real-world experience is a big advantage, especially in law. Through the placement, you'll get to see what working in a law firm is really like: meeting lawyers, learning how cases are handled and building your confidence.

We're committed to supporting young talent. Many of our paralegals and trainees go on to become outstanding lawyers and over the past two years, we've offered permanent roles to 90% of our trainee solicitors.

Each year, one student from a non-fee-paying school in Cambridge will be awarded the Hewitson Grant – named in honour of Hewitsons' long-standing legacy in the city.

#### You could receive:

- £5,000 to help fund a legal qualification of your choice
- Work experience with HCR Law during your second or third year of study.





The Hewitson Grant is available to Year 12 or 13 students who are ambitious and keen to explore what a career in law might look like.

Your school can nominate up to four students to apply. You'll just need to submit either a short video or written application introducing yourself and explaining why you should be awarded the grant.

Your teacher will shortlist two students to go forward to an interview with us.

# What should I include in my application?

Your application is your chance to show us who you are, so be creative and let your personality shine through! You can submit either:

- A short video (up to three minutes)
- A written application (Word document).

You can be as creative as you like but make sure you:

- Tell us a bit about yourself and why you're interested in a career in law
- Explain how you'd use the grant and what difference it would make to you
- Highlight the skills and qualities that make you a great fit for law.

If you'd like to create a video application, there's no need for specialist equipment – a simple video shot on a phone is fine.

The deadline for applications is 31 March 2026.

Your school is working with us directly to coordinate entries.
Your teachers have all the details to help guide you through the process and will be your first point of contact if you have any questions.

If you're interested in applying, make sure you've put yourself forward and start thinking about what to include in your application.

We're excited to hear from you and look forward to meeting the shortlisted students.
